**Subject: Guidelines for Project Work in HISTORY for Classes XI and XII
i.e. the academic session 2013-14 and for the Board Examination 2014 for Class XII**

Dear Principal,

This has a reference of curriculum prescribed by the Board for the subject History for Class XII for the academic session 2013-14 wherein Project Work of 20 marks is required to be done. As the Committee of Courses in History has decided to include project work in both the classes XI and XII w.e.f. the academic session 2013-14, the Board has brought out guidelines for the Project work for teachers and students (Annexed with this circular).

Schools are directed to ensure that the project work is assigned to the students in groups and they should be supported in securing relevant resources and obtaining required permissions from museums, archaeological sites etc. for their project. Teachers should discuss the progress of project throughout the course of project and if required guide them in drafting, reviewing and finalisation of the report. Schools are also directed to suitably space the 10 periods assigned to the Project work throughout the "1st term". The schools must ensure that the students actually go through the process of investigation and exploration that leads to real learning rather than depending on any readymade material available outside. It is highlighted that the suggested exemplars in the guidelines are only for the reference of teachers and schools are expected to formulate their own original projects on the basis of given guidelines.

Kindly bring these guidelines to the notice of concerned teachers, students and parents.
