Subject: Observing Vigilance Awareness Week, 2014 in schools

Dear Principal,

The Commission has decided that this year the **Vigilance Awareness Week would be observed from 27th October to 01st November, 2014**. The theme of observing Vigilance Awareness Week this year is **“Combating Corruption - Technology as an enabler”**.

Corruption, a social evil has become widespread in our society. It has an adverse effect on the development of a nation; it needs to be eradicated so as to ensure the prosperity of a nation and quality life to its citizens. Involving technology at various levels of functioning enhances efficiency, transparency and accountability and helps in reducing corruption.

The schools may organize various activities during **Vigilance Awareness Week** reflecting the aforementioned theme. Few activities suggested are -

For Classes VI to VIII

- Slogan writing on ‘Root out Corruption before it roots in you’
- Debate on ‘e-ticketing has been effective in reducing corruption from booking system

For Classes IX- X

- Lectures by eminent personalities on ‘How e-judiciary has helped in making court proceedings more transparent ’
- Symposium on ‘e- procurement - an effective way of increasing transparency’

For Classes XI-XII

- Debate on ‘e-Governance-a way to smooth governance’
- Seminar on ‘ Effectiveness of e-taxation in making the system more transparent and efficient’

The abovementioned activities may be conducted in the schools to create awareness about the role of technology in helping to provide transparency, access and accountability at various levels and therefore strengthening our system by making it more efficient. This may further be helpful in combating corruption.
